



Fred Geuder also suggested that the City has significant costs related to maintenance of recreation facilities that should be addressed. Maintenance is and will continue to be a big issue.

We discussed the requirement for DNR approved plans. City of H.S. indicated that they would like an approved/updated plan. Pleasantview (currently with none), not sure if they are interested in having a plan. Friendship/Readmond would like updated plans although organized recreation has not been the focus. Both would be open to using this plan (for waterfront and trails) as their updated recreation plan.

There was discussion of the HARBOR, Inc. Proposal to DEQ to locate open space and develop PDR and how this might fit in with waterfront open space. It was agreed that efforts could focus on an organizational structure to plan, develop and manage trails and waterfront/open space.
