1. Brown indicates open debris burning is not permitted anywhere within the county.
2. Green indicates open burning is permitted and debris fires are allowed if proper precautions are taken.
3. Orange indicates there are burn permit restrictions in effect for this county. Select your county for information on what restrictions are in place.
4. Yellow indicates burn permits are not issued electronically for this county. For information on where to call for burn permit information.

UPDATES ARE MADE EVERY DAY BY 10:00 AM EASTERN TIME.

Click to select the county in which you intend to burn before lighting any open debris fire. For more information on burn permits, including details about the availability, restrictions and local information on Burn Permits for each town, click on the county name.

If "YES" appears in the Burning Permits for each county, open debris burning is permitted today.

If "NO" appears in the Burning Permits for each county, open debris burning is not permitted today. If you are in violation of state law if you burn debris without a permit.

You are responsible for any changes resulting from the weather on your responsibilities, restrictions, and guidelines.
